

It appears that the preferred option is to cover the bank with a concrete covering (shotcrete) and address the drainage issues to the lower properties.

The owner of 42 James will not be happy as this option will now impact his ability to purchase and use a significant part of the ROW behind his house. However it will solve his major concern which was solving the erosion/soil shifting problem behind his house.

I'm responding on behalf of Morteza, who is currently on annual leave.

The design work for the James Street right of way was handed over from \$.33(to the Urban Works team in early May, and Morteza has been liaising with the engineers to progress the design. We have received the fee proposal today to proceed with the documentation of the preferred design, which the team have commissioned. The site investigations and design will commence in June and be completed in July.

We have funds in the Right of Way Rehabilitation Program in 2022/23 which we expect will cover

the cost of the construction works.

The design proposed will no longer be a retaining wall, as per discussions with 3.33(, given the land is not proposed for sale. The proposal is that the existing battered surface will be reshaped to form a more uniform slope, subsoil drainage installed and then place a reinforced shotcrete capping layer over it. A concrete upstand will also be required at the base of the wall along the boundary to the lower properties to prevent stormwater run-off from entering the adjoining properties. The stormwater run-off will be discharged into the lower level of the ROW and will then be captured by the existing drainage system.


