3.D. COMMAND AND CONTROL.

3.D.1. COMMAND RELATIONSHIPS. A CDF DIRECTIVE TO COMAST ON THE COMMAND RELATIONSHIPS FOR OP CATALYST WILL BE ISSUED AS THE AUTHORITATIVE DOCUMENT FOR COMMAND AND CONTROL. IN SUMMARY, THE FOLLOWING C2 RELATIONSHIPS ARE TO APPLY:

3.D.1.A. COMAST IS TO EXERCISE THEATRE COMMAND (TCOMD) OF ASSIGNED FORCES FOR OP CATALYST.

3.D.1.B. A JOINT TASK FORCE (JTF) IS TO BE FORMED TO INCORPORATE ALL FORCES DEPLOYED TO THE MEAO. THE COMMANDER OF THE JOINT TASK FORCE (COMDJTF-MEAO) SHALL:

3.D.1.B.1. REPORT DIRECTLY TO COMAST;

3.D.1.B.2. EXERCISE OPERATIONAL CONTROL, THROUGH DEPLOYED COMPONENT COMMANDERS, OF ALL ADF FORCE ELEMENTS DEPLOYED TO THE MEAO; AND

- 3.D.1.B.3. EXERCISE NATIONAL COMMAND OF ALL ADF FORCE ELEMENTS DEPLOYED TO THE MEAO.
- 3.D.1.C. CDF WILL RETAIN A DIRECT AND IMMEDIATE RELATIONSHIP WITH COMDJTF-MEAO ON ISSUES OF STRATEGIC AND NATIONAL IMPORTANCE.
- 3.D.1.D. ADF COMBAT FORCE ELEMENTS DEPLOYED ON OP CATALYST MAY BE ASSIGNED WHERE APPROPRIATE, AFTER CDF APPROVAL, UNDER THE OPERATIONAL CONTROL OF AGREED US CENTRAL COMMAND COMPONENT COMMANDERS.
- 3.D.1.E. SITUATIONAL AWARENESS AND OPERATIONAL REPORTING WILL BE FUSED THROUGH COMDJTF-MEAO, WHO WILL BE THE PRIMARY SOURCE OF OPERATIONAL REPORTING FROM THE MEAO TO AUSTRALIA.
