**Notice of Decision**

This Notice of Decision is made today under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 1992 (WA) (Act)* by me in my role as Curtin University's Freedom of Information Decision-Maker.

**Background**

Curtin University (**University**) received your emails dated 21 May 2024 and 28 May 2024 requesting documents under the Act.

On 27 May 2024, the application fee was paid electronically, and this payment was acknowledged on 28 May 2024.

On 5 June 2024, the scope of your application was confirmed as ... *documents from Curtin Executive showing why the Lennon Wall [was] disallowed including the letter of outcome (Application)*.

It was also discussed that the inclusion of third-party personal information in the documents you requested could lengthen the process. Consent was sought to remove all personal information from the documents considered for release and this was received from you on 6 June 2024.

On 6 June 2024, you were notified that your Application was valid and that the due date for the Notice of Decision on release of the requested documents was 22 July 2024.

**Decision**

As a result of your Application, 5 documents were identified as being in scope. These 5 documents will be partially released to you as they contain matter that is considered out of scope.

**Fees and Charges**

**Review rights**

If you are not satisfied with this decision, you have a right to apply for an internal review.

- give an address in Australia.

There is no lodgement fee for an application for internal review and there are no charges for dealing with an internal review request.

If an application for internal review is received, it will not be dealt with by me or by any person who is subordinate to me. The outcome of an application for internal review will result in the initial decision under review being either confirmed, varied or reversed. You will be advised of the outcome within 15 days of receipt of your application for internal review.
