Quick points on case monitoring in the community:

- Drone footage over accommodation – to ascertain a) property risks, b) proximity to other properties/community/risk settings (eg: licenced venues).
- Risk assessments of the accommodation – for staff and community
- Case summaries shared with law enforcement agencies (ABF/State based police/AFP) which includes background, pictures of resident, accommodation layout.
- State based law enforcements/AFP/ABF and Home Affairs – sharing information and risks – to ensure monitoring in community
- Based on risk – program of monitoring for case example over a fortnight
 - o Daily phone calls – wellbeing/attitude/behaviours of concern
 - o Random home visits – s. 47E(d)
 - o Local police visited property (random times) s. 47E(d)
 - o Contact with workplace and co-located family (compliance on attendance and behaviour)
