Dear The FOI People,

I refer to your request on 5 June 2024, under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982 (FOI Act)*, in the following terms:

*All public speeches made by the Treasurer that contain a condemnation about the killing of children in the occupied Palestinian Territories, specifically in East Jerusalem, the West Bank and the Gaza Strip since the 7th October 2023. I require all draft and final versions of these speeches.*

I am authorised to make FOI decisions on the Treasurer's behalf.

I am satisfied that, after reasonable search, the Treasurer is not in possession of any documents within scope of your request. I have therefore decided to refuse your request under section 24A(1) of the FOI Act on the ground that relevant documents do not exist.

A statement setting out your rights of review in this matter is attached.

## **RIGHTS OF REVIEW**

### **Application to the Information Commissioner for review of a decision**

Section 54L of the FOI Act gives you the right to seek a review of the decision by the Information Commissioner.

An application for review must be made within 60 days of receiving the decision.

Applications for review must:

- be in writing;
- give details of how notices must be sent to you; and
- include a copy of the notice of decision.
