Dear Foibles,

The purpose of this letter is to give you a formal decision about access to documents that you requested under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982 (Cth)* (“**FOI Act**”).

I am an officer authorised under section 23(1) of the FOI Act to make decisions in relation to FOI requests.

We received your request on 5 July 2024. You have told us that you are seeking confirmation of the dates and times of any meetings between Australia Post’s CEO and Treasurer Jim Chalmers between 1 July 2023 and 1 July 2024 (“**Request**”).

Searches of Australia Post records were conducted by relevant team members for documents matching the description of your Request. A record of a meeting between Australia Post’s CEO and Treasurer Jim Chalmers (“**the Document**”) was found.

Formal decision

I have decided to grant access to the Document with irrelevant matter deleted in accordance with section 22 (section 22(b)(ii) applies when access to a document would disclose information that does not match the description of a request and is therefore to be regarded as irrelevant.)

Some information in the Document was considered irrelevant and has consequently been deleted.
