Terms of FOI request

I am not seeking drafts or duplicates of the above documents.

I ask this request be processed by the Office of the Assistant Minister to the Prime Minister.

Authorised decision-maker

I am authorised to make a decision in this matter on behalf of the Assistant Minister to the Prime Minister.

Material taken into account

In reaching my decision I had regard to:

- the terms of your request
- the Act
- the Guidelines issued by the Information Commissioner, under section 93A of the Act

Documents in scope

The Office has identified one document that falls within the terms of your request.

Decision

I have decided to grant access to the identified document except for information that may reasonably be regarded as irrelevant to the terms of your request under section 22 of the Act.

Review rights

If you disagree with the decision you may apply for Information Commissioner review within 60 days from the date of this letter. The Act does not provide for internal review of a decision by a Minister.
