Freedom of Information request - Processing Update and Notice of Charge

I refer to your request under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* ("FOI Act") on 10 November 2022 for access to:

"a copy of the Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation's estimates briefing pack, including back pocket briefs, for the 2022 October and November Budget Estimates."

Thank you for your email on 24 November 2022 confirming that -

- 1. You are "not interested in duplicate copies of documents or documents that have already been publicly released on media releases, media articles or media statements" and
- 2. You are "also happy to have the names of all junior departmental officials, and external third parties and any personal contact details to be redacted."

I am writing to provide you with an update and to advise you of my decision that you are liable to pay a charge in respect of the processing of your request.

I am an officer authorised under section 23(1) of the FOI Act to make decisions in relation to FOI requests.

Update

Following consultation with relevant CSIRO staff, CSIRO's FOI team have collated relevant documents and commenced reviewing them to assess whether information can be released to you under the FOI Act. We shortly plan to commence necessary consultation with several parties in order to obtain all relevant information that will assist in decision-making in accordance with the FOI Act and relevant FOI guidelines provided by the Office of the Australian Information Commissioner (OAIC).

Decision

In accordance with section 29 of the FOI Act and the *Freedom of Information Charges Regulations 1982*, my preliminary assessment of the charge you are liable to pay is \$913.50.

Your right to contend the charge

Under the FOI Act, you have the right to contend that the charge:

- has been wrongly assessed, or
- should be reduced, or
- should not be imposed.

In deciding whether a charge should be reduced or not imposed, CSIRO's FOI decision maker must take into account:

- i. whether payment of the charge, or part of it, would cause you financial hardship;
- ii. whether giving access to the document[s] is in the general public interest or in the interest of a substantial section of the public; and
- iii. any other relevant matter.

Payment of a deposit

As the charge exceeds \$100, a 25% deposit, namely, \$246.00 will be sought if the charge is imposed.

The time you have to respond and what you need to do

You have 30 days to respond in writing to this notice. We therefore expect a response from you by **4 January 2023**. By that date, you must do one of the following things in writing:

- agree to pay the charge (this will mean that you will not be entitled to access the requested documents until the full charge (other than any inspection charge) is paid);
- contend that the charge has been wrongly assessed, or should be reduced or not imposed and explain your reasons; or
- withdraw your request.

If you do not provide us with a written response by 4 January 2023, your request will be taken to have been withdrawn.

The period for processing your request is suspended from the day that you receive this notice and resumes on either the day you pay the charge (in full or the required deposit) or the day on which CSIRO makes a decision not to impose a charge.
