Appointment of Acting Solicitor-General

Law Officers Act 1964

I, QUENTIN BRYCE, Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council:

- (a) revoke, from 7 October 2012, all previous appointments made under subsection 11 (1) of the Law Officers Act 1964 (the Act); and
- (b) under paragraph 11 (1) (a) of the Act, appoint, to act as Solicitor-General during a vacancy in the Office of Solicitor-General in the period starting on 8 October 2012 and ending on 14 October 2012:
 - (i) Robert^{s 47F(1)} Orr; and
 - (ii) if Robert \$\frac{s}{47}F(1)\$ Orr is, for any reason, unable to perform the duties of the office or is on leave—Thomas \$47F(1)\$ Howe; and
 - (iii) if both Robert 47F(1) Orr and Thomas 47F(1) Howe are, for any reason, unable to perform the duties of the office or are on leave—Guy 47F(1)

 Aitken; and
- (c) under paragraph 11 (1) (a) of the Act, appoint, to act as Solicitor-General during a vacancy in the Office of Solicitor-General in the period starting on 15 October 2012 and ending on 15 April 2013:
 - (i) Justin Thomas Gleeson; and
 - (ii) if Justin Thomas Gleeson is, for any reason, unable to perform the duties of the office or is on leave—Robert^s ^{47F(1)}Orr; and
 - (iii) if both Justin Thomas Gleeson and Robert 47F(1) Orr are, for any reason, unable to perform the duties of the office or are on leave—Thomas 47F(1) Howe; and
 - (iv) if Justin Thomas Gleeson, Robert or and Thomas 47F(1) Howe are, for any reason, unable to perform the duties of the office or are on leave—Guys 47F(1) Aitken; and

Law Officers Act 1964

- I, QUENTIN BRYCE, Governor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Federal Executive Council and:
- (a) under subsection 6 (1) of the Law Officers Act 1964 (the Act), appoint Justin Thomas Gleeson as Solicitor-General of the Commonwealth of Australia for a period of 5 years beginning on the date of this instrument; and
