#### Logo

- Both elements must be visible on a single layout.
- The logo and wordmark can appear separately.

## Logo


- The MoAD logo needs to be used big and confidently in layouts.

- A neutral palette of black and white is supported by five accent colours.
- The five accent colours are to be used sparingly, as accents only.
- Use these action colours to emphasise information and bring to life our brand.

## **Typography**


- Acumin Variable font is a variable sans-serif typeface. It performs beautifully at display sizes but also maintains an exceptional degree of sensitivity for text sizes.
- Alternative fonts are Tenorite on Power Point and Arial on MSW



- This element is incorporated in all our marketing materials and can come to life in the motion graphics, digital screens, projections.








- Brand implementation is key to create a cohesive and memorable identity for the MoAD brand.


